



Tactical Weapons Control Instructor

This program is designed to prepare instructors to train their officers how to deal with Weapon Control in their duty assignment. Finally, there is a comprehensive weapon control system for dealing with all the weapon control situations that an officer is likely to face, i.e. firearms, edged weapons, clubs, and aerosol sprays. The program will develop a four step program for dealing with all the weapons that an officer may face whether they bring them to the scene, whether the subject brings them to the scene, or whether they are "weapons of opportunity" found at the scene. The program will build "awareness" of the threat, train officers how to "avoid" being assaulted or having their weapons assaulted, "retain" their weapons, if they are assaulted in a disarming attempt, and how to "disarm" a subject in a close quarters situation or if possible "defend" themselves with lethal force.
