



Low Light/Laser Instructor

This course will explore the tactical advantages of laser sighting system. Developed to provide the instructor with techniques and drills to train department personnel with laser sights. More than 60% of officer-involved shootings occur between 6:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m. This course is designed for LEO Firearms Instructors to instruct their officers to gain skills and develop an ability to win a confrontation during low light situations. Students must pass a written test, live fire standards drills and instructor evaluations to successfully complete the course. Topics that will be covered are:
