



Officer Survival: For the Marine Enforcement Officer

This course is designed for personnel assigned to marine enforcement duties. It will provide the Marine Enforcement officer with skills to increase their effectiveness during confrontations in the marine environment, and will give the Marine enforcement operator skills that will improve their operational ability during survival situations.

Topics covered:

- Defensive tactics for confined spaces (i.e. craft decks)
- Deploying firearms from the patrol watercraft platform
- Projectile ballistics on pleasure craft hulls
- Boarding craft on the water for enforcement contacts
- Swimming skills for survival
- Diminished light tactics for operation at night

Duration: 5 Days

Tuition: \$750.00

Ammunition: 500 rounds pistol, 250 rounds rifle or shotgun

Equipment Required: wrap around eye protection, hearing protection, brimmed hat, personal flotation device, pistol with at least three magazines, full duty belt (holster, magazine pouches, handcuff pouch, etc.) handcuffs, flashlight, rifle with at least three magazines or shotgun (long gun must have sling), swimming attire, rain gear.

If possible, students are requested to bring a patrol boat for the course.
