



Active Shooter Instructor

This course is designed to give the instructor the knowledge and skill to train first responding officers to an Active Shooter incident. Active Shooter incidents are becoming more prevalent in law enforcement and the need to train officers in how to respond has become a vital part of law enforcement training. Instructor development issues will also be discussed as students will be “hands-on” teaching practical skills throughout this course. These practical skills will be taught with its focus on tactics. Firearms drills will be taught using Simunitions, however, these same drills can later be applied to “live-fire” range drills or high level scenario based training.

Topics covered:

- Lessons learned from previous Active Shooter incidents
- Use of Site surveys to aid pre-planned responses
- Development of Patrol Response Team(s)
- Use of mobile Tactical Operations Center (TOC)
- Use of shields and other ballistic protection
- Outdoor rapid response rescue
- Determining the threat
- First responder tactics
- Breaching tactics and capabilities
- Tactical room entry and clearing
- Low light issues
- Practical drills

Duration: 3 Days

Equipment Required: Handgun and duty belt with full gear including body armor, flashlight and handcuffs. Some type of long gun (AR-15, M-4, Shotgun). It is highly recommended that each student provide their own certified simulation training weapon and certified protective gear for force-on-force training. If the student is unable to provide this training equipment, the necessary equipment will be provided however the student may not be issued a training weapon similar to their duty weapon.
