



School/Work Violence Workshop

The objective of this course is to prepare Police, Fire, EMS, City and County Government, Hospitals and Transportation Management and Command Staff to have a full mutual aid response to any serious act of violence in any school system in a timely manner. To initially have on scene all necessary resources and command structure to control the situation and protect the safety of the victims and responders in the quickest possible time.

This course is designed to develop a master plan outlining a protocol for response to any school in a given system and information on each individual school within that system (i.e. updated floor plans, aerial photographs, contact information for responsible parties such as Principal, School Resource Officer, etc.)

Focus is on a plan that is a combined effort of all the responding agencies and the school administration staff. Demonstrating how the plan will be reviewed, practiced, updated and improved on a continuing basis and explaining how to conduct periodic exercises to test the effectiveness of the plan.

Topics covered:

- Concept for having a system wide Crisis Response Plan
- Planning and conducting in-house training scenarios
- Documenting intelligence information on all school (Site Surveys)
- Responsibilities of students, faculty and administration during crisis plan activation
- Responsibilities of first responders: Police, Fire, EMS
- Setting up and running an Incident Command Post
- Transportation of un-injured to secondary collection point
- Accounting for all students and faculty and other employees including those who have been transported to a medical facility
- What to expect if a crisis does occur-dealing with parents, relatives and the news media and other logistical problems
- Dealing with the crimes scene and subsequent criminal investigation
- Providing mental health counseling and care for those in need after an incident
