



Tactical Emergency Medicine Support

The TEAM ONE TEMS (Tactical Emergency Medicine Support) course is a 3-day comprehensive introduction into the provision of tactical medical support to law enforcement special weapons and tactics (SWAT) personnel. The TEMS course begins with an overview of the provision of medicine in austere environments and, in those situations in which swat or tactical teams function.

The course is designed for first responders, EMT's, paramedics, and physicians who work with and/or are assigned to tactical operation teams and bomb squads. Participants should also have a working knowledge of both pistol and shotgun use and safety

Topics covered:

- Team health
- Medicine under fire, life saving procedures
- Medicine across the barricade
- Management of less lethal injuries victim
- Tactical team movement
- Less lethal munitions
- Chemical agent familiarization
- Hazardous material updates

Duration: 3 Days

Ammunition: 50 rounds of shotgun/slug, 300 rounds of pistol ammo

Equipment Required: Wraparound eye protection, ear protection, brimmed hat, pistol with three magazines and holster, duty belt, full tactical gear including body armor, comfortable clothing (e.g. BDU's) and gas masks.
