



Master Firearms Instructor

This course will develop and test the skills of the Master Firearms instructor. The firearms that will be covered are revolver, pistol, shotgun, semi auto rifle, sub machine gun and carbine. Each student will conduct a live fire range program; pass a shooting standard drill and written test on **all** firearms to successfully complete the course.

Topics covered:

- Safety rules and equipment
- Developing a realistic firearms program
- Range development and management
- Responsibilities of the firearms instructor
- Inventory control and allocation
- Logistical support and resources
- Response to Medical Emergencies
- Exposure to Range Hazards (Ear, Eye and Blood concerns)
- Use of marking cartridges
- Conducting safe live fire scenarios
- Training and use of equipment
- Shooting under multiple conditions
- Concealed carry operations
- Low light/laser techniques
- Target design and selection
- Ammunition, ballistics, evaluation and selection

Prerequisites: Completed a Firearms Instructor Course
 Completed Master Firearms Instructor on-Line program (part of this course)

Equipment required: Wrap around eye protection, ear protection, brimmed hat, body armor, pistol with three magazines, holster and duty belt, Shotgun w/ ammo pouches and sling, Rifle w/ two magazines and pouches and sling, Revolver w/ two speed loaders and holster, Carbine or submachine gun with two magazines and ammo pouches and sling. Other equipment will be provided.
