



Master Firearms Instructor

This course will develop and test the skills of the Master Firearms instructor. The firearms that will be covered are revolver, pistol, shotgun, semi auto rifle, sub machine gun and carbine. Each student will conduct a live fire range program; pass a shooting standard drill and written test on **all** firearms to successfully complete the course.

- Developing a realistic firearms program
- Responsibilities of the firearms instructor
- Shooting under multiple conditions
- Concealed carry operations
- Low light/laser techniques
- Non Standard Response
- Relative Position Drills
- Firing on the move at moving targets
- Course and Target design and selection

Equipment required: Wrap around eye protection, ear protection, brimmed hat, body armor, pistol with three magazines, holster and duty belt, Shotgun w/ammo pouches and sling, Rifle w/ two magazines and pouches and sling, Revolver w/ two speed loaders and holster, Carbine or submachine gun with two magazines and ammo pouches and sling. Other equipment will be provided.
