The Range Master has overall charge of the range. This position usually occupied by the most experienced Firearms Instructor. This course will further develop the Firearms Instructors' knowledge in order to become a Range Master by expanding their skills in the safe and efficient management of a firearms range and training program.

- Use of marking cartridges
- Conducting safe live fire scenarios
- Developing department policies
- Legal and Liability update
- Critical Incident review and analysis
